

**CITY OF WEST POINT, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE 2006-02**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE WHICH ESTABLISHED TAP IN FEES TO WATER LINES IN THE CITY OF WEST POINT, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of West Point, Kentucky adopted Ordinance 2006-02 which imposed a tap in fee to water lines

WHEREAS, it is hereby recommended to the City Council to grant approval for the following proposed changes to the ordinance:

The Code of Ordinance for the City of West Point is amended by the following changes to Chapter 50:

Section 50:40 Changes for use of water system for all customers in the City of West Point; tap in and meter charge

(B) The tap in and meter charges shall be as follows:

<u>Tap in charge</u>	<u>Rate</u>	
	<u>Old</u>	<u>New</u>
Water Tap- 5/8 inch by 3/4 inch meter	\$500	<u>\$550.00</u>
1 inch by 1 inch meter	\$500	<u>\$750.00</u>
2 inch by 2 inch meter	\$750	<u>To be charged at actual material and labor cost</u>

Additional \$200.00 per service if road crossing is required.

Read at a meeting of the West Point City Council on the 13th day of February. A second reading was held on 13th day of March 2006. Said ordinance was read, passed and approved on the 13th day of March 2006.
