

Ordinance 2005-09
City of West Point, Kentucky

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CITY OF WEST POINT AD VALOREM TAXES FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2006, ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TAXING JURISDICTION OF THE CITY, ON EACH ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) OF FISCAL YEAR 2005 ASSESSED VALUATIONS TAKEN FROM THE HARDIN COUNTY PROPERTY VALUATION ADMINISTRATOR AS FOLLOWS: ON REAL PROPERTY .3420 .3560 AND ON PERSONAL PROPERTY .4017 .3770 INCLUDING REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY OF SERVICE COMPANIES AND PRIVATELY OWNED AND REGISTERED VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WEST POINT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That for the purposes of support of the government of the City of West Point, and the payment of its debts and expenses, there will be and hereby levied ad valorem taxes on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the Fiscal Year 2005 assessed valuation of all taxable property within the taxing jurisdiction of the City as follows:

- A. Real property and personal property (personal property includes inventory, furniture, and fixtures of business, including inventory held for resale, and privately owned registered vehicles), including real and personal property of public service companies on the Department of Revenue assessed valuation.

Real Property .3420 .3560
Personal Property .4017 .3770
Bank Deposit Tax .00025

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage and publication, as required by law.

Read at a meeting of the West Point City Council on the 12th day of September 2005 and a second reading was held on the 26th day of September 2005; said Ordinance was Read, Passed and Approved on the 26th day of September 2005.
