Ordinance 2006-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE WHICH ESTABLISHED A
RECONNECTION FEE ON WATER SERVICE THAT HAD BEEN
DISCONNCECTED WITHIN THE CITY OF WEST POINT, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the City Council of West Point, Kentucky adopted Ordinance 2006-01 which imposed a reconnection fee for water service to customers that had been disconnected due to non-payment of bill.

WHEREAS, the City Council seeing a need to raise the reconnection fee, wishes to amend said ordinance by increasing the fee from \$20.00 to \$30.00 to reconnect a customer to water service.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of West Point, Kentucky as follows:

Section 1. If a water customer is disconnected from service due to non-payment of water bill, to reconnect to water service they are to pay a fee of \$20.00 \$30.00. After customer has paid the reconnection fee and the past due water charges, the City of West Point will then restore water service to customer.

Read at a meeting of the West Point City Council on the 9th day of January, 2006. A second reading was held on 13th day of February, 2006. Said ordinance was read, passed and approved on the 13th day of February, 2006.
