The City of West Point has completed a planning study on hazard mitigation to the threats posed by destabilization of the Ohio River bank along the outer edge of the community. The study efforts focused on the right ascending bank of the Ohio River between junction with the Salt River and 9th Street. A final information meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, December 3, 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. at the Old West Point School, 209 North 13th Street. The public is invited to attend.

Representatives from the City and their design consultant firm will share information from an assessment of a selected stabilization method. The public will have the opportunity to review the study report and comment at the meeting.
