## CITY OF WEST POINT 2007-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 152.052 OF THE WEST POINT'S LAND USUAGE ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WEST POINT, KENTUCKY, THAT CITY ORDINANCE CHAPTER 152.052 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

## 152.052 NON CONFORMING USES AND STRUCTURES

- (6) Travel trailers, and recreational vehicles in place and being used as a dwelling is a non-conforming use. As of January 1, 2007, these vehicles will be allowed to remain in their current state, but are required to obtain a conditional use permit on an annual basis. All conditional use permits will expire on June 30 of each year. The Travel trailer/recreational vehicle must be licensed, roadworthy and tow able, and must be moved a minimum of one (1) mile every 180 days. The existing vehicle may not be replaced, extended, or modified without application for a new permit.
- (7) Travel trailers/recreational vehicles must be licensed, roadworthy and tow able, and must be moved a minimum of one (1) mile every 180 days.
