**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 152.052 OF THE WEST POINT'S LAND USUAGE ORDINANCE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WEST POINT, KENTUCKY, THAT CITY ORDINANCE CHAPTER 152.052 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

152.052 NON CONFORMING USES AND STRUCTURES

(6) Travel trailers, and recreational vehicles in place and being used as a dwelling is a non-conforming use. As of January 1, 2007, these vehicles will be allowed to remain in their current state, but are required to obtain a conditional use permit on an annual basis. All conditional use permits will expire on June 30 of each year. The Travel trailer/recreational vehicle must be licensed, roadworthy and tow able, and must be moved a minimum of one (1) mile every 180 days. The existing vehicle may not be replaced, extended, or modified without application for a new permit.

(7) Travel trailers/recreational vehicles must be licensed, roadworthy and tow able, and must be moved a minimum of one (1) mile every 180 days.

Read at a meeting of the West Point City Council on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of June 2007. A second reading was held on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 2007. Read, Passed and approved at a meeting of the West Point City Council on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 2007.
