Have the River Day's moved they money yet. Gaye Moore stated al the paperwork was ready for the bank. We met with Feeding American and they are interested in a food pantry.

Richard stated he had three possibilities for Police Officers.

Richard Ciresi stated there will be a swearing in on December 30, 2022, it has been moved to 5:30 at the gym. Fran Moore stated Light up West Point the kids received good stuff, we have the Angel Tree is taking care of. House decorating contest will be December 18th.
