ORDINANCE 2023 – 01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST POINT, KENTUCKY, REVISING THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICE RENDERED BY WEST POINT WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City of West Point, Kentucky, has received a 41.2% increase in the cost of water purchased from Hardin Co. Water District No. 1

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the water rates charged to the citizens to offset these costs,

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of West Point, Kentucky, as follows:

Section 1. Revised Monthly Water Rates. The rates and charges for water services furnished by West Point Water System are hereby revised as follows:

A. Minimum Water Rate: There shall be a minimum usage charge of 2,500 gallons of water in each month for all years mentioned herein.

B. Meter Rates for Water: Effective date of this Ordinance the following water rates shall apply for the year 2023 effective March 2, 2023:

2501 and up	\$	7.49	\$	9.15


There will be no change in the sewer rates as determined by ordinance 2015-02

Section 2. Severability. If any clause, provision, paragraph or section of this Ordinance be ruled void or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder thereof is intended to be enacted and shall be in full force and effect notwithstanding.


Section 3. All former Provisions in Conflict Repealed. Effected date of this Ordinance, all orders ordinances, motions or parts thereof, insofar as same may conflict herein, are repealed and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
